

CAMP ROLES & RESPONSIBILITIES 2026

Health Coordinator (1)

~Recruiting~

- Collects camper medications at check-in
- Inventories first aid supplies at the beginning & end of camp
- Locks up medications when not in use
- Administers daily meds to campers
- Provides preventative care, first aid, and mental health first aid
- Advises leaders on COVID-19 precautions
- Determines when EMS needs to be called
- Determines when the attendee needs to be sent home for illness
- Remains at camp when injured/ill attendees need offsite care
- Provides camper supervision when counselors are off-duty

Counselor (10)

~Recruiting~

- Cabin co-leaders for up to 8 campers
- Serves as a bridge between campers and staff
- Looks after the well-being of campers in their care
- Mediates conflicts between campers in their cabin
- Brings unresolvable conflicts to Camp Pastor or OMC for support
- Knows where their campers are at all times
- Gets their cabin to activities and meals on time
- Leads Choose-Your-Own-Adventure activities
- Designs & leads one worship experience
- Advocates for camper needs to OMC
- Reports camper's physical/mental health needs to Health Coord.
- Reports all other emergencies/crises to OMC
- Gathers all cabin members at the fire circle or storm shelter ICE
- Role model to younger campers and their peers
- Keeps cabins tidy and free of food
- Submits daily check-ins to the Asst. Camp Director during dinner

Counselors-In-Training (6)

- Supports cabin counselors for up to 8 campers
- Serves as a bridge between campers and adults
- Looks after the well-being of campers in their care
- Mediates conflicts between campers in their cabin
- Knows where their campers are during downtimes
- Gets their cabin to meals on time
- Leads Choose-Your-Own-Adventure activities
- Designs & leads one worship experience
- Advocates for camper needs to OMC
- Reports camper physical/mental health needs to Health Coord.
- Reports all other emergencies/crises to OMC
- Gathers all cabin members at the fire circle or storm shelter ICE
- Role models to younger campers and their peers
- Keeps cabins tidy and free of food
- Submits daily check-ins to the Asst. Camp Director during dinner
- Attends daily sessions with campers in their age group
